... dishonored the memory of minority leaders in government and the military by ordering their entries to be removed from online archives...

... cut Medicaid, SNAP, and other safety net services that disproportionately serve minority communities...

... targeted people of color in their purges of government and military positions of leadership...

... largely excluded people of color from their selections for government service (all but one of Trump’s 24 Cabinet members are white)...

... targeted communities with large minority communities for military invasion, beginning with Washington, Los Angeles and Chicago...

... and with their assault on Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion (DEI) they have pushed thousands of minority workers out of jobs and legitimized racial stigmatization.

But the most insidious manifestation of this new era of white supremacy is reflected in Republican abortion bans. For the first time since the abolition of slavery, white males are re-exerting their control over the bodies of Black women.
