The Trumpian Avalanche

By the time you read *Trumpianity*, much of it will have been overtaken by events. Trying to stay ahead of the Trumpian Trainwreck is like trying to outski an avalanche. During the four weeks I was finishing my final edits, these were among the headlines.

- It was revealed that Donald Trump, who has been pressuring the Federal Reserve Board to lower interest rates, earlier this year purchased \$100 million worth of bonds for his own account. The price of bonds increases when interest rates fall so Trump will personally profit when the Fed gives in to his duress and lowers interest rates. *The conflict of interest is glaringly obvious*.
- The FBI raided the home and office of John Bolton, Trump's former National Security Advisor turned harsh Trump critic, in a marked escalation of Trump's weaponization of the Department of Justice to harass and intimidate people he sees as his enemies. The timing of the raid was clearly set to create a distraction from release of the first batch from the Epstein files to Congress that same day.
- After Putin told Trump that mail-in balloting cost him the election in 2020, and seeing the handwriting on the wall for losses in the midterm elections, Trump threatened to issue an executive order to end the use of mail-in ballots and voting machines and to require voter ID. *Meanwhile, Putin was seen convulsed on the Kremlin floor in fits of laughter.*

- A federal judge issued an emergency order over Labor Day to stop the Trump administration from deporting more than 600 *unaccompanied* Guatemalan children as young as 10 years old *(this moral atrocity from an administration that claims to be pro-life and pro-family)*.
- A federal court of appeals upheld a Court of International Trade ruling that Trump's tariffs were illegal and that he had exceeded his authority by declaring an emergency to justify them.
- The IRS launched a frantic recruiting campaign to rehire Internal Revenue Service employees who had been fired or laid off during the first Trump-Musk purge.
- > Trump threatened to send U.S. military troops to take over Chicago and other Democratic cities. In late night social media rage posts he wrote, "I love the smell of deportations in the morning. Chicago about to find out why it's called the Department of WAR!" and threatened that he was going to "wipe out" protestors in Portland, Oregon. Trump has so cowed military leaders that there was not a peep of dissent from the Pentagon about this unconstitutional use of our armed forces against the civilian population.
- ➤ In Washington D.C. National Guard troops who were sent in response to Trump's imaginary "crime emergency" were put to work on sanitation and landscaping not being done because

- Trump had previously laid off 90% of the National Park Service staff who had been doing the work. When Trump crowed about having eliminated crime in DC, it appears he was talking about the crime of littering.
- ➤ Trump fired the Commissioner of the Bureau of Labor Statistics for having told the truth about weak job growth; fired the Director of the U.S. Defense Intelligence Agency for having told the truth about the limited effectiveness of bomb strikes on Iranian nuclear facilities; fired the Director of the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention for having refused to rubber-stamp the anti-science agenda of anti-fax fanatic RFK Jr.; fired one of the CIA's most highly-regarded Russia experts to cover up for Trump's own failure to reach "a deal" with Putin to end the war in Ukraine; placed 140 EPA staff on unpaid leave in retaliation for having signed a letter voicing concerns about Trump's environmental policies; fired a senior career ethics official at the U.S. Department of Justice; forced the resignation of U.S. Attorney for the Eastern District of Virginia after he refused to bring charges against Trump critic Letitia James; and attempted to fire a Federal Reserve Board Governor by fabricating a dubious criminal allegation to cover up the real reason she is a black woman who has not caved in to Trump's demand for lower interest rates. - Florida's surgeon general announced that the state would be the first to end all childhood vaccine mandates, thus assuring that Florida would continue its right to lay claim to having the nation's highest concentration of elderly people by increasing the state's future childhood mortality.
- More than 85 climate experts contributed to a comprehensive report excoriating a Department of Energy document written by five climate skeptics falsely claiming that the impact of climate change has been overstated in other words endorsing Trump's lie that global warming is a hoax.
